
I am directed to refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the reply of the State Government, it has been observed that the following information/clarification are required to be submitted:

- i. Duly filled prescribed proforma (copy overleaf) by the DCF concerned clearly showing details of the remittance of CA levies, etc., be submitted; and
- ii. Non-forest land provided by the user agency for compensatory afforestation should be mutated in favour of forest department and documents for the same be submitted.

3. The compliance to the above may be submitted within 60 days from the date of issue of this letter failing which the proposal shall be liable to be rejected for want of information.
