**FACT SHEET OF THE PROPOSAL**

**Name of the proposal** Diversion of 31.833 ha of forest land (closed under section 4 & 5 of PLPA 1900) in favour of Addl. Divisional Manager, Haryana Tourism Corporation, Sunbird, Surajkund for rejuvenation of Badkal Lake in Village Badkhal, under Forest Division and District Faridabad, Haryana, &  
Diversion of 0.359 ha of forest land in favour of Executive Engineer, HSVP, Horticulture Division, Faridabad for laying of treated water supply line from Sector 21 A STP to Badkhal Lake, under Forest Division and District Faridabad, Haryana

1. This proposal was discussed in the 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> REC meeting held on 28.02.2020 & 12.03.2020 and again on 37<sup>th</sup> REC meeting held on 16.02.2021 wherein the committee directed the Government of Haryana to refer the matter to the legal wing/department and seek their legal opinion whether the sale deed in the instant case can be considered as legal proof of transfer of land.
2. Accordingly this office sought the above information from State Government on 25.02.2021
3. The State Government submitted reply on 17.09.2021 along with 'Note of DLR & DS(Op.) for L.R & Admn Secy. to Govt. of Haryana, Law and Legislative Department' and 'Report of Tahsildar Badkhal' and 'Order dated 06.08.2021 of Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Government of Haryana without giving its opinion on legal status of land in question.
4. The Law and Legislative Department Note is as under:

*As regard to the issue as to whether the sale deed (as Flag at Flag 'Z' in the A.D.'s file) in the instant case can be considered as legal proof of transfer of land it is clarified that the document placed at Flag 'Z' shows that the same is an approval issued under rule 12(2) of the Punjab Village Common Land (Regulation) Rules, 1984 by the Secretary to Government, Haryana Development and Panchayat Department to the Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon for the sale of shamat land by Gram Panchayats Ankheer and Badkhal to the Tourism Department, Haryana and as such cannot be considered as registered sale deed. 'Sale' as defined under section 54 of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 with regard to any immovable property reads as under:*

*"Sale" is a transfer of ownership in exchange for a price paid or promised or part-paid and part-promised.*

*Sale how made: Such transfer, in the case of tangible immovable property of the value of one hundred rupees and upwards, or in the case of a reversion or other intangible thing, can be made only by a registered instrument.*

*In the case of tangible immovable property of a value less than one hundred rupees, such transfer may be made either by a registered instrument or by delivery of the property.*

*Delivery of tangible immovable property takes place when the seller places the buyer, or such person as he directs, in possession of the property.*

*Contract for sale.-A contract for the sale of immovable property is a contract that a sale of such property shall take place on terms settled between the parties.*

*It does not, of itself, create any interest in or charge on such property."*

*Thus, in view of above legal position the sale of said land @ Rs. 1000/per acre as involved herein was required to be made by way of registered instrument*

*and if not so executed, the same cannot be termed/considered as legal proof of transfer of land. However, before proceeding further A.D. is advised to seek the opinion of Development & Panchayat Department as the land/matter relates to it.*

5. The order dated 06.08.2021 conveying the order of Financial Commissioner, Revenue & ACS to Govt. of Haryana by Dy. Secretary Revenue (LR), inter-alia states “.....*The said land includes the land sold by the erstwhile Gran Panchayats Ankhir & Badkhal to the Tourism Department vide Endst no.CLG-3-72/26747-51, dated 5th July, 1972 measuring 244 kanal 13 marla and 1228 Kanal 16 marla as well as other land acquired by the Tourism Department in these two revenue estates. Thus, there is no scintilla of doubt about the ownership of the Tourism Department in these lands and there was no necessity of sceking the advice of LR in the matter.....*”

6. Earlier fact sheets dated 12.-03.2020 and 16.02.2021 are also enclosed.

  2. Accordingly this office sought the above information from State Government on 09.03.2020 & 12.05.2020 and also sought comments of State Govt of this office letter dated 13.02.2020.
  3. The State Government/user agency submitted incomplete reply on 16.9.2020 and 06.11.2020. After detailed examination of this project this office sought following information from State Governemnt on 25.11.2020 which is as under.
    - i) User agency /state Governemnt shall produce the Gazetted Notification/Executive order of ownership/possession of Badkhal lake.
    - ii) Comments of State Government w.r.t reply submitted by user agency of this office letter dated 12.03.2020.
  4. The reply from the State government is still awaited.

**12.** After examining the proposal, this office sought following information from the state government on 13.02.2020:

- i) Since the proposal involves diversion of forest land (deemed forest) i.e., area closed under Section 4 & 5 of PLPA in Faridabad District wherein on the advice of CEC, the proposals of non-public utility have been kept pending till the final decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court, more so, as the User Agency is a profit making organization (State PSU). Please comment.
- ii) It is proposed to fill the Badkhal Lake with waste water after treatment as available from Sector 21 A, Faridabad and the user Agency has mentioned in part-I the EC is not applicable . Please elucidate the mechanism for maintaining water quality.
- iii) The exact lake area, main bund area and left over catchment area are not defined in the project report. The entire vegetation is proposed to be removed without mentioning state of vegetation on periphery/bund side of the lake and remaining catchment area. Please comment.
- iv) Staircases & ramp area (0.147 ha) as proposed seem to be permanent structures which should be temporary and eco friendly. Please comment.
- v) No CAT plan activities have been proposed and no participation of technical departments like forest, soil conservation, fisheries etc. and local village residents/Resident Welfare Societies is proposed in the project report. Please comment.
- vi) The User Agency is not exempted from providing equivalent non-forest land, hence equivalent non forest land be provided for CA.

- i) Project site:  
On DSS analysis, no issue observed in proposed project site.
- ii) CA site:  
Three CA sites are proposed by the State Government in different components of Faridabad range. On DSS analysis it was found that out of 116.372 ha, only 55.6 ha vacant space is available and remaining 60.772 ha more vacant space is required for target plantation.
